SYMPATHETIC CONSERVATION AND (WHERE NECESSARY) RESTORATION OF OLD AND LISTED BUILDINGS

Over many years John Wardle has gained experience, working on many old properties and structures.

Whilst a large proportion are listed, the view is that all old properties (listed or not) should be treated with respect.

Repairs should be traditional and materials shall be in keeping with the existing fabric where possible. Original features must be conserved.

A conservation engineering approach generally leaves the structure of the building, historically correct, but stable.
