

WEST HILL HOUSE, DARTFORD

CONSTRUCTION OF TWO STOREY EARTH RETAINING STRUCTURE TO PROVIDE FOUNDATIONS FOR 3 STOREY TIMBER FRAMED HOUSING OVER

The site is situated on a steep easterly facing (down) slope. The earth retaining structure is being constructed to support the 3 storey timber framed housing above.

Due to the complex nature of the lower ground floor, together with the necessity for a tower crane base to be provided at the top of the lower retaining wall, has lead to quite complex involved calculations and construction.

Project on site 2005/2006. Likely to be structurally complete by mid 2006.
